ROAD SAFETY ...

Please remember to encourage all children to:



- **STOP** at designated crossing points before crossing the road, including car park entrances and exits which children may not automatically recognise as being roads.
- **LOOK** both ways before attempting to cross roads or driveways.
- **LISTEN** for traffic approaching.
- **CROSS** safely, continuing to look both ways when crossing roads.

Use paths and pedestrian routes to school, rather than crossing car parks, where possible. As there are a number of car park crossing points on the walk to school, we would also ask that parents are extremely vigilant of their children who may not identify these points as roads.

Please remember that Clayburn Road and the public car park next to Hampton Library and Leisure Centre are very busy in the mornings and afternoons and that extreme care should be taken when driving to and from school, along Clayburn Road and in the car park. Please ensure that you enter the car park using the entrance nearest the building and leave the car park using the exit nearest the secondary phase building.

A smooth and safe start to the school day ..

Please can we remind all parents & carers that the school gate opens at 8.40am and from **Monday 18 May** will be closing **five minutes earlier** at **8.55am prompt**. This enables all children to be on time for registration which takes place at 9.00am.

When bringing your child into school please could we ask that you leave by the school gate before 8.55am so that the children can be ready for the register and help them to become more independent and settled with their morning routines.

If you arrive after 8.55am you should take your child to the office where they will be signed in and taken to the classroom.

We would also like to remind you that the school car park is for staff, disabled drivers, visitors and taxis and should not be used for dropping off or picking up. An increasing number of people are coming into the car park and also using the car park as a thoroughfare. From Monday 18 May the car park gate will be locked at 8.30am and only unlocked for staff, disabled drivers, visitors or taxis. Please could we ask that parents and children use the pedestrian gate and pathways into school as this is safer than walking across the car park. We apologise for any inconvenience caused but we are sure you will all support the school in ensuring that our children's safety is our top priority.
