Absence due to illness.

If your child is poorly and cannot come to school please can we ask you to telephone us on **01733 246821** before **8.30am** and leave a message on the primary phase voicemail. This will enable our administrative staff to update the class registers to show which children are absent due to illness. It is important to telephone us again on each day of absence to keep the registers up to date.

If your child has suffered from sickness or diarrhoea we ask that your child is kept off school for **48 hours** following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. This is to ensure that any sickness or stomach bugs don't spread to other children in school.

Certain conditions do not require children to be kept off school. If you are in any doubt, please contact your GP or NHS Direct. You could also speak to Mrs McAlister who is able to advise on exclusion periods for different conditions.
