Punctuality in the mornings...

Our school gate is open from 8.40am until 8.55am every morning for children arriving to school. We aim to close the gate promptly at 8.55am to ensure that children are settled in class before registration at 9.00am.

If you arrive at school after 8.55am, please could we ask that you sign in at the school office to ensure that your child's attendance is recorded on our registers for that day.

We appreciate that there are certain days when traffic problems can cause children to be late to school, or events happen that make us late in the mornings, but if everybody could try to get children into school for 8.55am it does mean that the children can be settled into school and make a good start to their day. Arriving at school persistently late can have an impact on children's learning as they begin to become unsettled in their school routine or miss out on key elements of their learning.
