Summer Term Sun Safety...

As the spring is settling in, and summer is just around the corner, please remember to send your child to school with additional sun protection as the temperatures begin to climb.

- ⊗ **Water bottles** enable children to drink during the day to prevent thirst from setting in. Please make sure these are sent to school pre-filled with water at the beginning of the day - they can then be topped up as / when the children require.
- ⊗ **Sun hats** will protect children from the sun and also help to shield their eyes. Please make sure these are named.
- ⊗ **Sun glasses** may be worn at break and lunchtime. Children must ensure they look after their sunglasses and put them in their tray or book bag during lesson time.
- ⊗ **Sun cream** can be applied before school and reapplied at school **by your child** if they need to be 'topped up'. Please ensure that any sun cream is clearly labelled with your child's name. Unfortunately, due to allergies, children should not be encouraged to share sun cream with their friends.
- ⊗ Summer uniform can be worn this term including summer dresses, shorts, t-shirts without jumpers. Children should still have a jumper or coat in school, in case the weather changes and the rain sets in.
