Y2 Morning Routine...

In order to encourage our Y2 children to be more independent in the mornings, we would like to ask parents and carers to drop their children off at the Y2 cloakroom door each morning where a member of the Y2 team will be on duty each morning to meet and greet our children and parents and deal with any messages or queries. The children will then be able to go into their cloakroom and classroom independently and prepare for their day ahead. If any parents have messages to pass on to their child's class teacher, the Y2 adult at the door will be able to take these messages and pass them on. Alternatively, parents are still very welcome to go through to speak to their child's class teacher if the message is urgent, private or confidential.
