As part of the Year 4 Cornerstones topic 'Traders and Raiders', on Tuesday 19 October the children will take part in a Viking workshop. The children will participate in activities providing a view of who the Vikings were, where they were from and the important legacy they have left behind. Children will become a Viking for the day, discovering how people lived, worked and travelled between the years 400AD and 1066AD. Replica artefacts from daily life will be available such as tools and clothing, as well as weapons and armour so the children can learn raiding, trading and invading.
