Dear Parents and Carers,

Covid-19 measures in school

You will be aware that we have had a cluster of Covid-19 cases at Hampton College Primary and as a result have some additional measures in place this week, particularly in Year 5 and Year 6 classes (such as separate break and lunchtimes).

We wanted to let you know that we have also received a recommendation from Peterborough City Council and the Director of Public Health for Peterborough to increase our Covid-19 measures at this time. This is in response to a significant rise in cases in the Peterborough area and these recommendations have gone to all schools in Peterborough.

We do not think these new measures will impact upon the children, as they relate to the adults who work in or visit our primary schools.

The following measures will remain in place for adults and will be reviewed at the start of November:

- Face coverings to be worn by school staff in corridors and communal areas
- Adult visitors to the school to wear a face covering (unless they are exempt)
- Parents evenings and school events to remain virtual

We would like to take the opportunity to ask you to remain vigilant and to not send your child to school if they have Covid-19 symptoms.

Thank you all for your tremendous support, which has been evident since the start of the pandemic. The staff in our school are working very hard to make life as normal as it can be. We have made real strides forward this term and very much hope that the reintroduction of some temporary Covid-19 measures will not detract from the children's enjoyment of school.
