



Hampton College Primary Phase Topic Overview

Year 1 Topic: School Days



Computing

We will improve our keyboard and mouse skills by using the computers in the Tech Tunnel. We will learn how to log on and open a word document to type a sentence about our school.

Art

We will learn about a famous artist called Wassily Kandinsky. We will practise our colour mixing and use our painting skills to create our own picture in the style of Kandinsky.

English

We will continue to practise our phonics and blending skills, particularly focusing on Phase 5 digraphs.

During our daily ELLA time we will develop our reading comprehension skills, answering questions about the books we read.

We will read a variety of stories, and explore the characters and settings. We will retell the stories making sure we include a beginning, middle and ending. We will continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our sentences. We will improve our sentences by using interesting adjectives and connectives such as 'and', 'because' and 'so'.

Music

We will have music lessons taught by Mr Powell from the Secondary Phase.

Mathematics

This term in maths we will be broadening our number knowledge and focusing on place value to 100. We will explore the value of coins and learn to tell the time using O'clock and half past.

Science

We will revisit the seasons, focusing on Summer; noting the changes from previous seasons we have explored. We will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

We will identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Religious Education

This half term we will learn about the Sikh religion, finding out about their traditional baby naming ceremonies. We will find out the meanings of our own names and talk about how all families are special. We will create our own class special book and keep it in a safe place.

Physical Education

During our indoor PE lessons, we will be learning how to play inclusive team games, solving problems and engaging in new activities fairly. During our outdoor PE lessons, we will be learning athletic skills, such as running, jumping, throwing and using hurdles.
